Film Fest 919 collaborates with Rick Warner of UNC Chapel Hill's English and Comparative Literature program to give students from surrounding North Carolina Universities the chance to become involved with the festival including special opportunities to engage with industry professionals – directors, screenwriters, producers and Academics – for their own master class, enabling them to make connections and gain further understanding of the film industry.
